

Job Description

Newtown Partners is an early-stage venture capital firm that actively invests in emerging, disruptive technology startup businesses. Founded and run by successful startup entrepreneurs, Vinny Lingham, and Llew Claasen, Newtown Partners has an entrepreneurial focus that goes beyond investment. The team operates out of offices in Cape Town, South Africa and Sunnyvale, California (Silicon Valley). The firm has a strong track record of investing in successful technology businesses at the forefront of innovation. Newtown's current portfolio of 25 technology startup companies (as at November 2018) have achieved returns of between 2x and 200x over the past 4 years.

We are recruiting for a Venture Capital Analyst to join the investment team in the Cape Town office at Newtown Partners.

The investment team's primary goal is to find and invest in the best technology companies early on as the first institutional capital. In this role, you will identify companies we should meet based on both signals ("what's trending?") and theses ("what do we believe will happen in a specific market?"), contribute to the investment diligence and decision process, and collaborate with the team and startup ecosystem.

Responsibilities

- **Find interesting companies:** proactively identify and screen new investment opportunities and qualifying inbound leads for the firm based on quantitative signals, market theses, and a network of key relationships. You will work with deal partners to identify what signals are relevant, develop predictions about how specific markets are evolving, meet with entrepreneurs and track activity in the startup ecosystems in South Africa, US and select European and Asian markets.
- Evaluate prospective investments: assist in the overall diligence on specific companies
 we are considering investing in, or an entire category of startups we are evaluating. Specific
 tasks will include capturing notes during pitches, market research, product reviews,
 competitive analysis, customer/user reviews, analyzing metrics (financial, customer, user,
 engagement, etc.), understanding the history of a category, and other tasks related to the
 evaluation of an investment.
- Assist in managing the Newtown portfolio: collaborating with the team to support the management of portfolio investments, including regular evaluation and strategy development.
- Co-author "thought pieces" (in the form of blog posts, presentations, etc.): work with
 the team to co-author thought pieces for general consumption as well as for more specific
 audiences (e.g. corporates, news outlets).
- Ad hoc research: Perform business and technology research on markets, companies, and themes that the firm is interested in
