Cleo Paskal, Chatham House

Global warring

Cleo Paskal is an associate fellow in the Energy, Environment and Resources department and the Asia-Pacific Programme at Chatham House. Her research examines the increasingly strategic confluence of geopolitical, geoeconomic, and geophysical changes. She has consulted or briefed for a wide range of stakeholders, including the Foreign and Commonwealth Office, Royal College of Defence Studies (UK), US. Army War College, National Defence College (India), National Defence College (Oman), the German Foreign Office, the EU, and heads of major corporations, and security professionals from over 30 countries. She has been widely published and makes frequent media appearances. Her book, *Global Warring: How Environmental, Economic, and Political Crises Will Redraw the World Map* (Macmillan, 2010) has won multiple awards.



Cathy Haenlein, Royal United Services Institute

Environmental crime and organised crime gangs in the developing world

Cathy Haenlein is a Senior Research Fellow in RUSI's National Security and Resilience Studies group, where she leads the Institute's research stream on serious and organised crime. Her research focuses on environmental crime (wildlife crime, illegal fishing) and illicit trade, particularly in East and Southern Africa. Cathy is the Chair of RUSI's Strategic Hub for Organised Crime Research, established in partnership with the Home Office, National Crime Agency, Foreign and Commonwealth Office, and Research Councils UK's Partnership for Conflict, Crime and Security. She is the editor, with M L R Smith, of *Poaching, Wildlife Trafficking and Security in Africa: Myths and Realities* (Abingdon: Taylor and Francis, 2016). Cathy has undertaken research on behalf of the European Commission, British government and Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development, among others, conducting fieldwork in Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia, Madagascar, the Seychelles, Gabon and Sierra Leone.

Exploiting poverty (Global threats overview from an NGO perspective)

He is the principal assistant to the Commanding General for planning, coordinating, directing, supervising, and training on Stability Policing, counter terrorism, counter organized crime and Security Sector Reform. Since 2016, Lt. Col. Pani has been providing the Alliance with innovative and cutting-edge tools for future stability operations. He has extensive international experience having served in several leadership and operational roles managing sizeable multi-disciplinary projects and groups, in permissive and hostile environments, in Asia, Africa, Eastern Europe and the Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS).



Darryl Dixon, Gangmasters and Labour Abuse Authority

Human trafficking

Darryl is responsible for the Gangmasters Licensing Authority's future strategy, encompassing development of new powers, regulatory and innovative enforcement approaches and international exchange agreements supporting cross-border operations. Previously he held responsibility for several operational teams including compliance, enforcement, intelligence, licensing. The functions of the teams ensured that labour providers are compliant, and remain compliant, with the standards expected of the GLA, to be fit to hold a licence; and that those who operate outside the law are identified, and, where appropriate, prosecuted. Darryl's previous posts include Assistant Director, Licensing at the Security Industry Authority and Manager, Professional Standards Unit of the Counter Fraud Investigation Branch of Department for Welfare and Pensions, where he was responsible for the investigatory practice for welfare fraud investigators. He holds an MSc in Security Management from the Scarman Centre for the study of Public Order, of Leicester University; and is a Fellow of the Security Institute.

John Barradell OBE is the Town Clerk & Chief Executive of the City of London Corporation. With an active involvement in resilience at a London-wide and national level, John is Deputy Chairman of the London Local Resilience Forum (LRF) and the Chairman of the Local Authorities Panel of the LRF. Prior to joining the City Corporation, John's career spanned local government, the private sector, and the voluntary sector, serving as Chief Officer of the Special Constabulary for the Metropolitan Police Service.

Security conscious?

Dan Breger has delivered corporate security transformation/ remediation engagements across most industries over the last two decades.
