Role Description Venue Security



Summary of the role

Help ensure our marquees and other venues are kept safe over-night and that Butlin's are kept informed of any security issues.

You will need to be confident that you can stay awake throughout the night and happy to be working during as part of a small team when the resort is at its quietist.

The Venue Security team play a vital role in keeping our venues and equipment safe and secure whilst everyone else is sleeping. You will have a radio and need to maintain contact with Butlin's Resort Safety throughout the night, with regular debrief meetings with the Event Coordinator to discuss any issues.

You don't need to have any previous experience, but you do need to be sure that you are capable of working through the night and catching up on your sleep during the day.

WHAT YOU COULD BE DOING:

- Attending a briefing at the beginning of the week outlining responsibilities of the role
- Patrolling vulnerable areas overnight
- Watching over equipment in the marquees and stands in the retail/exhibition areas overnight
- Communicating with Butlin's security staff during shift
- Reporting issues/incidents to Event Co-ordinators

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- To cope with responsibility
- To be able to work at night and sleep during the day
- To use a two-way radio (training will be provided)
- To stay awake during the hours of 9pm and 8-30am

WORKING PATTERN

• This is an overnight role, typically commencing around 9pm and finishing at approximately 8.30am, with food and rest periods provided.

TEAM SIZE:

- 4 volunteers per break at Skegness and Minehead only
- 4 volunteers over the Easter weekend at Minehead

VOLUNTEERS MUST BE:

- over 18 years of age
- able to complete an on-line application and provide referee details
- happy to work within the EA Basis of Faith and Lausanne Covenant

VOLUNTEERS WILL RECEIVE:

- free team accommodation (shared rooms)
- three meals a day
- travel expenses up to £80
