What to do if you need a vet in an emergency

Bransgore Vets operates an out of hour's emergency veterinary service in conjunction with Vets Now

Contact Bransgore Vets and follow the advice on the answer phone message

If you have been directed to the Vets Now Emergency Clinic their address is:

PDSA Pet Hospital Castle Lane West Moordown Bournemouth BH9 3JU

The emergency clinic operates out of the PDSA PetAid Hospital. Vets Now are a specialist veterinary emergency services who provide emergency cover and treatment for Bransgore Vets clients and their animals when we are unavailable.

Directions from Bransgore Vets, Total distance 9 miles, estimated driving time 25 minutes:

- 1. Turn left out of Bransgore Vets onto the Ringwood Road (0.3 miles)
- 2. Turn left onto Derritt Lane (1.8mlies)
- 3. Turn left onto Salisbury Road B3347 (0.1miles)
- 4. Bear right onto Ringwood Road B3347 (0.8miles), pass Woolpack Pub, Sopley on right.
- 5. Turn left onto Avon Causeway, signposted Hurn (1.7mlies)
- 6. At Hurn Bridge roundabout take the first exit onto Christchurch Road B3073 (0.8miles)
- 7. Go straight on at the traffic lights and continue on B3073 (0.1miles)
- Turn left at next traffic lights onto Slip Road, signposted Bournemouth, A338 (0.2miles). Continue onto A338 "Spur Road" (1.1miles)
- 9. Take First Exit off A338 (0.2miles). At roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Castle Lane West A3060, signposted Wimborne (0.7miles)
- 10. At roundabout take the 1st exit onto Castle Lane West A3060 (0.3miles)
- 11. At roundabout take the 2nd exit onto the A3060 (0.5miles)
- 12. At roundabout take 2nd exit onto A3060 (0.4 miles)
- 13. The PDSA PetAid Hospital is located on the left, next door to and just before a Kwik Fit Centre
