Mission

The Doe Fund's Young Professionals Council (YPC) is an action-oriented group charged with supporting the Ready, Willing & Able program through philanthropic activities and by raising the program's public profile, engaging existing and securing new donors including institutions and corporations, and engaging in volunteer work with the men whom we serve in order to become well informed advocates of the program.

Structure: The YPC is comprised of a minimum of 7 and a maximum of 30 professionals.

Member Responsibilities

- Commit to a one year membership term
- Attend quarterly YPC Meetings
- Volunteer at least 6 to 8 hours per year with Ready, Willing & Able trainees.
- Serve on at least one YPC Committee
- Raise the profile of The Doe Fund and the Ready, Willing & Able program in the public space through social media, specifically engaging with influencers
- Donate a minimum \$1,500 directly to The Doe Fund, including through the sale of tickets to
- Dishes by Doe and the annual Gala, or through third-party donations or assets
- Attend 80% of special events
- Attend at least three of four quarterly Council meetings in person or via conference call
- Serve as an ambassador for The Doe Fund by personally recruiting new donors and corporate sponsors and engaging with the organization's existing base of supporters

Term of Membership:

The Term of membership shall be one year; however, all member terms shall end on June 30th each year, regardless of the dates on which the members joined.

Joining the Council:

Any individual willing and able to meet the requirements set out in this Charter may request to join the Council, either directly to the Council Co-Chairs or by recommendation of an existing member of the Council, a Board member or The Doe Fund's Development Office.
