Central California Women's Conference to Award Valley non-profits \$100,000 in funding

The <u>Board of Directors</u> of the Central California Women's Conference (<u>CCWC</u>) is honoring 81 nonprofits serving women and children with grants totaling \$100,000. Recipients will be recognized at CCWC's Community Celebration Reception on Wednesday, April 11.

To date, CCWC has donated more than \$1,000,000 to Valley non-profits serving women and children. Funding has benefited recipients by providing an array of services ranging from mammograms to food, shelter, clothing, education, and more.

CCWC also serves through its CCWC/Wells Fargo College Preparatory Scholarship Program. In 2017 20 students from Fresno, Sanger, McLane and Central (east campus) high schools participated. They each received a scholarship, attended the conference, and also participated in a financial literacy workshop. In addition, CCWC partners with AT&T for its re-entry scholarship program, where five deserving women receive a scholarship, attend the conference and are hosted at a celebratory luncheon. And, through its partnership with PG&E, last year CCWC awarded its second "She Makes a Difference" award to Trisha Cooper for her work with Exceptional Parents Unlimited.

Now in its 31st year, more than 90,400 women have attended the Central California Women's Conference since its inception. This year's event will be held on Tuesday, Sept. 25. Tickets go on sale in early June at ccwc-fresno.org. The 2018 CCWC presenting sponsor is Community Medical Centers.
