It does mean that we can work closely with families to both support and challenge at an early stage in a child's educational journey. It also means that the transition from nursery to primary and from primary to secondary are managed so that students are excited about the next stage of their development.

Personalised learning

As a learning organisation, we base our practice on educational and psychological research, making decisions about learning based on evidence.
