The construction of this beautiful summer home began with the blasting of the rock bluff to make room for the pool and sauna located on the lower level. This home boasts of cherry floors and custom cherry cabinet work throughout. Special systems built into this project include geothermal heating and cooling, emergency generator system, a three phase electrical service, and independent water and sewer system. The open courtyard is paved in stone that accents the glass, stone, and redwood wall finishes. This house is capped off with a standing seam copper roof and gutter system. The entire project overlooks the Osage River on a 140 foot bluff.
