Here at Ashridge Court we offer our residents the highest possible quality of life, while providing them with an exceptional standard of residential and nursing care, including respite and palliative care. We also offer specialised dementia care within our dedicated dementia unit, the Hazel Wing.

We provide the very best care for all our residents, and support our staff in their continual professional development, including specialist training in caring for the frail, elderly and those with dementia. We have a large number of professional nurses on the team, and the majority of our healthcare assistants are trained to or working towards NVQ or Diploma Levels 2 and 3 in Health & Social Care. Together, the nursing and care staff look after our residents' wellbeing, comfort and health 24 hours a day.


Before you come to live at Ashridge Court we'll invite you and your relatives to come for a cup of tea, so you can meet the staff on duty, have a proper look around, ask questions, and discuss your requirements in detail. During this visit, the centre manager or a senior registered nurse will also carry out a pre admission assessment of your nursing needs, so that we can agree on and arrange for the right level of care for you.

Person centred care

You will be allocated a key worker, who is there to take a special interest in you and help us provide you with the right care in the right way. Your key worker means there's always a friendly and familiar face looking out for you, and the close relationship between you also facilitates the sharing of information with you and your relatives.

The staff in our specialist unit for dementia, the Hazel Wing, all have an in depth understanding of the unique behaviours that dementia presents, and provide person centred care focused on an individual's strengths.


The Hazel Wing offers accommodation for sixteen residents in bright and comfortable rooms, each with an ensuite wet room bathroom. A secure decked terrace provides accessible yet safe outdoor space overlooking the garden and offering beautiful views over the countryside and down to the coast.

Residents take part in specialist activities designed to improve their social, emotional and spiritual wellbeing by tapping into their past skills, experiences and interests, and also benefit from stimulating new experiences (such as interacting with visiting 'pet pals', and Snoezelen therapy, for example).

We have been delighted with the results we have seen in those participating, with improvements noted in areas such as balance, body part awareness, appetite, understanding, self esteem, mood and behaviour, as well as better engagement with others. We have also seen those receiving the therapy developing greater trust in those closest to them, leading to deeper, more rewarding relationships with carers and family members.

Delicious and nutritious meals



Our modern, light and spacious care home sits within beautiful countryside near the East Sussex coast, and offers accommodation for 69 residents, including 16 rooms in the Hazel Wing, our dedicated dementia facility, which has its own lounge, dining room and sensory room.

Ashridge Court has a number of bright and comfortable lounges and dining rooms, including the Channel View and Hazel lounges.

Our restful decks and private gardens, which are wheelchair accessible, offer magnificent views over the East Sussex countryside and toward the coast.

We also have a variety of specialised moving and handling equipment and hoists, together with a choice of comfortable pressure relieving mattresses and cushions, as required.


Our bright and comfortable rooms all feature:
