Minutes from the last meeting

Pulse Regeneration working in partnership to deliver Trafford Council's Third Sector Infrastructure Development and Support Service







Minutes and actions from the last meeting were discussed including an update on the success of the Trafford Volunteer Awards, Coop Digital community research project in Stretford, the Volunteer Quality Standards, and Inclusive Neighbourhood grants available through the Trafford Partnership team.

GoodGym Trafford

Kate Frain from GoodGym Trafford talked the group about the new initiative and how people can get involved and request tasks and activities to be completed by the GoodGym volunteers.

Wednesday night Group run tasks at 7pm - GoodGym-ers meet at St Matthew's Community Hall in Stretford and run up to a 5 KM radius to tasks that are scheduled with charities and community organisations in advance with Kate. GoodGym can do pretty much anything for you from dropping off leaflets, to moving boxes, to prepping for painting, to sorting out gardens and even helping out at events. We want to free up your time for the important stuff! *Tools and briefing on the night from the beneficiary organisation are required* Group Community Missions - GoodGym-ers meet at the beneficiary organisation and complete a pre-arranged task on a weekend or other agreed time. Again, GoodGym can do all sorts for you and on a day to suit you!

Coach Runs - Kate also explained about individual referrals for "Coach" runs (where a runner runs each week to visit an older isolated person) and one-off individual "missions" (participants of both of these are regulated by strict processes and procedures as you'd expect). Examples of missions include putting up new curtains, tidying up a garden or moving furniture around at an individual's home.
