Are you looking after somone?

If you are looking after an ill, frail or disabled family member, partner or friend, then you are a carer. The person you look after may be elderly, have a physical or mental health condition, a learning disability or a drug or alcohol dependency (diagnosed or undiagnosed). People often don't view themselves as carers, and as a result can miss out on the various rights, benefits and support which may help them in their role.

When a carer first contacts us, we go through a registration process to make sure that we provide the most appropriate support. Then we can help in various ways: Providing information and signposting to other organisations; giving one to one support, including benefits advice and working with other services; and providing some opportunities for breaks and making friends.
