Who we are

Insight Education is an educational consultancy and career advancement service based in London

that provides a roadmap into British schools, universities and international employment. We work with our international partners to provide a seamless service of support to students from around the world.

Our expertise is in demystifying Oxbridge admissions and helping students to maximise their chance of success. We aim to develop student confidence, independent study skills, critical thinking and self-reliance as the foundations for success at school, university and career.

What we do

We set out to help families achieve the educational goals for their children at three stages:

1. Entering UK boarding schools

For many overseas students, English language is the biggest barrier to entry into UK universities. Insight Education advises on appropriate summer and/or language schools that combine English teaching with cultural and educational experiences.





Through attending, children can acquire fluency in English that will help them access UK boarding schools and gain those academic qualifications that enable them to compete effectively for places at the UK's top universities.



2. Entering British University

We run a highly successful Oxbridge Mentoring Scheme (OMS) which academically stretches students and maximises their chances of getting into Oxford or Cambridge universities. Through the OMS, our students gain a broader subject knowledge, an understanding of how to tackle Oxbridge-style questions and gain the self-confidence to face any interview scenario. This



holistic approach is invaluable for students aiming to compete for Oxbridge and has also led to students securing places at, for example, London School of Economics, King's College and Imperial College.



3. Entering international employment

During and after university studies, we work with students to be pro-active about exploring career avenues. We equip them with workplace skills by supporting their application to secure work placements with companies abroad.

Following graduation, we review CVs and cover letters and improve interview technique through job-specific mock interviews. We encourage self-reflection and analysis of skills and attributes to

ensure job hunting is targeted. Our overall support enables students and graduates to get a head start in building their own futures in an increasingly competitive job-market.



Why we are unique

All our tutors are Oxbridge-educated and we have developed a framework of support that can be tailored to the individual needs of students. Our tried and tested framework consists



of Oxbridge-style tuition covering topics beyond the school curriculum, interview practice and advice, UCAS brainstorming and critical review and guidance right the way through the Oxbridge admission process. We help ensure that student success stems from their own efforts, academic achievement and intellectual curiosity for their chosen university course.







Of the OMS students who were called for Oxbridge interviews between 2006 and 2013, 52% secured offers. This is far higher than the average Oxbridge application success rate which is approximately 20% (2012/13 Oxford and Cambridge application statistics). The OMS is also useful in helping students gain admission to university in general. Since 2006, 99% of students aboard our schemes secured places at other top (Russell Group) universities.





The OMS

We have three OMS programmes to support the academic needs of our students. We begin with a consultation, followed by a written report advising students and their parents which programme to pursue. All of our OMS programmes include:

- ✓ Academic mock interviews with written feedback
- ✓ Recommendations for subject-related reading
- ✓ Advice on course and college choices
- **✓** UCAS brainstorming and critical review
- ✓ Oxbridge-style tutorials for entrance tests
- ✓ Practice in answering Oxbridge interview questions

OMS Bronze (1 year) Programme: runs from January of Year/Grade 12 to December of Year/Grade 13. It includes 12 hours of tutorials with reading on a level with undergraduate studies, UCAS brainstorming and review.

OMS Silver (2 year) Programme: runs from January of Year/Grade 11 to December of Year/Grade 13. It includes 36 hours of tutorials followed by OMS Bronze Programme.

OMS Gold (3 year) Programme: runs from January of Year/Grade 11 to May of Year/Grade 13. Includes silver and bronze programmes, two weeks at Oxbridge summer school and an additional 20 hours of tutorials, if a conditional offer is secured.

Note: commencement of dates are flexible. We produce bespoke programmes of support. Where needed English language tuition is available on request. Tutorials take place via Skype or in person.

Robert Jones - Cambridge Admissions Advisor



The roadmap

In addition to running the OMS, Insight Education provides other educational services in conjunction with its business partners. Our roadmap consists of 5 interconnected services:

Access to English education via placements in summer cultural and English language course in London, Oxford and Cambridge and other UK locations, and sourcing suitable UK boarding schools.

Out-of-school tutoring in GCSE and A level subjects to ensure the best grades to apply to UK universities. This could include English as a Foreign Language for international students preparing for IELTS or TOEFL tests.

Mentoring into Oxbridge and other British universities, including support for writing UCAS personal statements, interview practice and entrance test preparation.

Gaining job skills and work experience via placements and internship programmes in companies in the UK and abroad.

Mentoring into appropriate employment during studies and after graduation through CV analysis, letter writing, interview practice and skills-specific job hunting.














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
