
Standard Quotation Terms & Condition's:

Quotation

All production tooling prices included in this package are part cost budget prices only.
All component prices included in this package are budget costs only.

All prices to be held firm for 30 days from date of quotation.

Tooling

All tooling costs within this quotation are based on a fine spark finish, and/or polishing.
No chemical etching has been allowed for.
Initial samples will be supplied from fully hardened dies, and submitted with a full quality package.
Any changes or modifications required to prototype or production tools will be charged at cost.

All tools carry a 500,000* shot guarantee after which time repair, maintenance or replacement will be at customers cost.

Raw Material & Bought in Components

All aspects of the component price within our control will be held. Any increases in raw material or bought in components which are beyond our control will be advised and passed on within 30 days of notification of price movement.

Payment Condition Components

*Within 30 days of the end of the month in which the invoice is dated.
Currency is GBP.

Product Supply

Product is supplied on an ex-works basis.*
All prices are based on components packed in standard Cameron-Price cardboard carton stacked onto Euro Pallets*. All cardboard cartons are collapsible and recyclable.

Delivery

Delivery of first off samples to be agreed from receipt of an official order and fully dimensioned production release drawings.

CAD Data

Delivery will be quoted from receipt of fully dimensioned production released 2D drawings, and fully defined production released 3D CAD data.
Unless otherwise stated in writing from the customer it will be assumed that the 2D & 3D data are identical, and therefore either one can be used to cut production tooling independently from the other.
Cameron Price accepts no responsibility for faults occurring in production tooling due to errors in either 2D or 3D data provided by the customer.

Part Cost

All tooling/assembly/testing equipment is sold on a part cost basis, which means that Cameron-Price contributes towards the costs of development and production of all tooling. No tooling can therefore be removed from Cameron-Price without the full cost of development first been settled (for the avoidance of doubt development is costed at 30% of the invoiced tooling value) and in any event not within 60 days of formal notification.
