

#### **Honeybourne Parish Council News**

#### Neighbourhood Development Plan: NDP

It was reported to the Council that the plan is progressing very slowly, and the lack of parishioner support is causing the data collecting to be very tedious and protracted. It's your community's parish plan and its your village. Get involved in its future development and join the plan group.

#### **Parish Precept**

The Parish Council have concluded the council's financial requirements for 2018-19 and gave careful consideration to supporting the funding of the new Community Centre as 2018 will see the project move forward with the £400,000 lottery funding now secure and planning consent for the old Village Hall site is in place. The 2018-19 Parish Precept of £87,000 was unanimously agreed by the council. This is a small increase on last year which will possibly amount to an 8.2% increase and an increase of £8.27 per year for a band D property. This is just less than 16 pence per week.

#### **Cemetery Thefts**

The Parish Council have considered installing CCTV at the cemetery following thefts of Christmas wreaths and other vandalism. After considering the possible problems and logistics involved the proposal will be considered again at the February council meeting.

#### **Street Naming**

The new development of five bungalows off Stratford Road requires a street name and following many suggestions it was agreed that the street name for the development should be St Ecgwin Close.

#### **Pavilion Cleaners Wanted**

A professional cleaner who can be contracted to attend to all pavilion cleaning matters will be needed to start in the early spring. Anyone interested should contact the Parish Clerk.

#### **New Planning Application for Fancutts Garage**

A Planning application for the demolition of disused garage and erection of five dwellings was fully supported by the Parish Council as it offers a well-designed small development in place of the existing garage. This new application has been received at the same time as the previous application eight dwellings was granted by Wychavon District Council.

#### **Pelican Crossing and Roundabout**

Cllr Alastair Adams offered an encouraging report for a Pelican Crossing on Station Road and the possible need for financial support from the Parish Council, a request for further information on funding has been made but no response received to date. The County Council highway officer's negative report on the proposed mini roundabout at the Gate Inn cross roads will be further pursued as the council contest the information in the report.

#### **Christmas Tree Event**

The Parish Council has agreed to donate £1,300 to the Village Hall Committee from the event fund and light sponsorship.

The Parish Council meets on the 2nd Tuesday of each month. Members of the public are welcome to attend meetings, which are held in the Village Hall and commence at 7.15 pm. Residents are welcome to speak on any issue of local concern during the Open Forum before the start of the meeting. Clerk John Stedman





#### Letter from the Vicar

#### 'Love is all around'

Amongst other things, February brings with it St Valentine's Day. This is a day when we should reflect on love and on what love is, giving thanks for the human love that we receive from, and share with, the one closest to us. Cards, of varying degrees of tastefulness, help us to convey the love that we feel!

But, what is love? I think the world has become increasingly befuddled by love. We confuse it with liking or enjoying something very much. And, let's be honest, we confuse it with sex and even lust. Love, though, is something deeper, greater and more wonderful than all of those things.

For Christians, it is impossible to think about love without thinking about God – the author and creator of love. In particular, we think about God's love revealed in Jesus Christ. To know what real love is like, we look to the cross where Christ was crucified and there we discover the characteristics of genuine love. This love is, first and foremost, enduring – it lasts through good times and bad. It is forgiving. It is selfless. St Paul describes real love like this,

"Love never gives up. Love cares more for others than for self. Love doesn't want what it doesn't have. Love doesn't strut, doesn't have a swelled head, doesn't force itself on others, isn't always "me first', doesn't fly off the handle, doesn't keep score of the sins of others, doesn't revel when others grovel, takes pleasure in the flowering of truth, puts up with anything, trusts God always, always looks for the best, never looks back, but keeps going to the end. Love never dies." 1 Corinthians 13: 4-8 (The Message)

This is what God's love for us looks like and somehow, in the brokenness of our humanity, this is the sort of love that we should try to emulate in all of our relationships. It's not easy and it requires constant work and dedication – I speak from experience!

Because of where Easter falls this year, St Valentine's Day is also the beginning of the season of Lent – Ash Wednesday. This is a time when Christians prepare themselves for the great celebration of Easter and the eternal hope that comes with Christ's resurrection life and light. Before Easter, of course, comes the pain and desolation of Good Friday and Christ's once-for-all death on the cross. We'll think more about that next month.

For now, though, I'd like to encourage us – and I very much include myself in this – during Lent, not just to 'give something up' but, instead, to think about love and about how in our dealings with others we can live out that Godly love that St Paul was writing about.

Imagine what our lives, our relationships, our communities and our world would be like if we all committed ourselves to that...

Well, after 100 years of the affiliation of railway clubs up and down the country our very own Western Region was forced to close on 31st December 2017 due to financial shortfalls and the closure of several clubs. Our Taunton-based headquarters was set up 25 years ago, taking over from the now demised "British Railway". It was very sad indeed to say farewell to the General Secretary, Mrs Tracy Baker, and her comrades, for all their hard work.

Our club here in Honeybourne remains open as usual but is about to be sold on in the next couple of months. However, the Association's "Help in Hand Charity" will make sure that it is business as usual and the sale of the club will not have any effect at all.

I am sad to report that our Club Secretary for many years and the village's former chimney sweep and railway signalman, Mr John Perry, passed away recently. Our condolences go to his family and friends.

The club's membership price (due 1st March – 31st March) has increased for the first time in many years and is now £10 for single membership and £20 for family membership which includes children up to their 18th birthday. I have taken steps to leave bar prices for members at £2.60 a pint, £2 a double short and £1.20 for a single short. Members CANNOT purchase drinks for visitors and guests at this prices; they have to pay full price or apply for membership, which works out as 20p a week for a single or 40p a week for a family membership. It's good value for cheap bar prices!


