All requests for non-traditional & unusual bicycles must be submitted by the corresponding National Federation in writing for ITU approval at least seven (7) days before the event in which the athlete wishes to compete in, with a clear explanation and a minimum of five (5) high resolution pictures attached to this form.

The solicitant will be informed by the ITU on the outcome of the request once the ITU Technical Committee has reviewed the information.
