*Pro Pilot* subscribers scored FBO selections from 1 (poor) to 10 (excellent) in 6 categories—Line Team, Customer Service Representatives (CSRs), Facility, Amenities, Promptness & Efficiency and Value for Price.

#### Ranking Criteria for US FBOs

For 2015 the total number of ranked US FBOs was 40. A minimum of 21 respondents with 6 categories give a 126 individual evaluations from *PP* subscribers was the threshold for ranking in the Top US FBOs.

#### Most Improved FBO—Atlantic SNA (John Wayne Airport, Santa Ana CA)

This award is given to the FBO that made the largest gain in ranking position as compared with the previous year. Atlantic SNA didn't rank in the top 44 in the list of 2014 USA FBOs but moved up into the 26th position in 2015. Hence, Atlantic SNA advanced by at least 19 positions to win Most Improved US FBO for 2015.

In the *Pro Pilot* PRASE Survey the definition of a small chain is 3–10 bases. A large FBO chain contains 11 or more. Those FBOs with only 2 locations are considered as 2 separate independents. FBO groups classified as networks are not considered FBO chains. PRASE judges established these definitions in 2011.

FBOs acquired by the chains after Jul 1, 2014 retained their former affiliation for this 2015 PRASE Survey.

## 2015 PROFESSIONAL PILOT PRASE METHODOLOGY

*Pro Pilot* uses a 3-step process to ensure accurate PRASE survey results.

- 1 Ballots were sent to subscribers in 4 waves.
- Forms were sent with the Nov 2014 and Dec 2014 issues of Pro Pilot.
- Forms were mailed separately from the magazine in Jan 2015 and then in Mar 2015.
   The subscriber was instructed to return the completed ballot to *Professional Pilot* in Alexandria VA.
   Cutoff date for the 2015 PRASE Survey was Apr 15, 2015.

Strict checking was done and no more than 1 ballot per participant was allowed. Voting was restricted to only qualified *Pro Pilot* readers. In categories where they compete organizations or individuals are not permitted to submit ballots. Public relations, marketing and advertising personnel are ineligible.

Ballots are always checked thoroughly to ensure all information listed is current and correct. Careful verification of FBO names is made since some names change because of mergers or acquisitions.

The 2015 PRASE Survey received a total of 1641 ballots. Of those 1348 met the *Pro Pilot* acceptance criteria. A total of 293 were disqualified due to inconsistencies, errors, duplications, lack of information or lateness.

- 2 Qualified ballots were shipped to Conklin & de Decker to transfer the data from the original forms to an electronic database.
- **3** Database information was analyzed and tabulated by Conklin & de Decker of Arlington TX as a precount and a preliminary step to determine the rankings and winners. The winners list was finalized on Apr 23, 2015.
