HAY FEVER SEASON!

As the nice weather approaches, Hay Fever can strike! There is currently no cure for Hay Fever but you can do things to ease your symptoms when the pollen count is high.

DO

- put Vaseline around your nostrils to trap pollen
- wear wraparound sunglasses to stop pollen getting into your eyes
- shower and change your clothes after you've been outside to wash pollen off
- ✓ stay indoors whenever possible
- keep windows and doors shut as much as possible
- vacuum regularly and dust with a damp cloth
- buy a pollen filter for the air vents in your car and a vacuum cleaner with a special HEPA filter

DO NOT

- do not cut grass or walk on grass
- do not spend too much time outside
- do not keep fresh flowers in the house
- do not smoke or be around smoke – it makes your symptoms worse
- do not dry clothes outsidethey can catch pollen
- do not let pets into the house if possible – they can carry pollen indoors

Save money on NHS prescriptions by prepaying for them. You can pay a set price for prescriptions for 3 or 12 months, no matter how many you need.

A prescription costs £9.00 per item, but prepaying for an unlimited number of prescriptions is

- **£29.10** for **3 months**
- £104 for 12 months (or 10 Direct Debit instalments of £10.40)
