

The 6o-minute documentary show cased the epic battle between 21 Sikh Soldiers who were stationed at an army post and were attacked by around 10,000 Afghans. The Sikhs, led by Havildar Ishar Singh, chose to fight to the death, in what is considered by some military historians as one of history's greatest last-stands.
