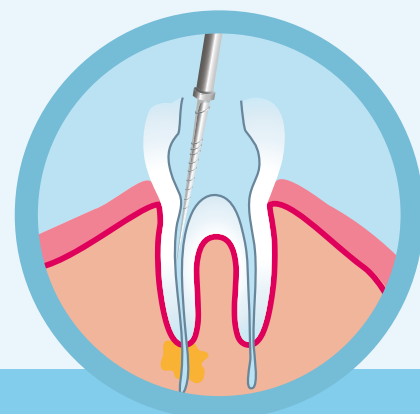


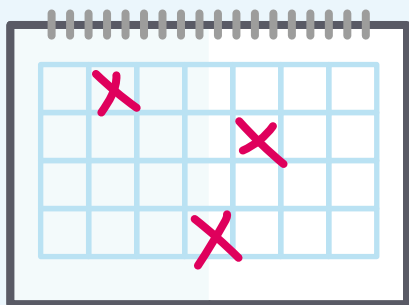
# ROOT CANAL TREATMENT



Root canal treatments are among the most often completed dental treatments. However, usually it is only chosen if there is no better way to save the tooth and the nerves need to be removed from the tooth root.

## EASING PAIN

A root canal treatment can be a **solution** if you experience **extreme pain** or **swelling**. This might be a sign that the infection has reached your nerve, in which case your root canal needs to be cleaned out and sealed.



## MORE APPOINTMENTS


Completing a root canal treatment **takes more visits** to make sure that before the permanent root filling (and maybe even a crown or an onlay) is placed, all the infection is fought off. At the first appointment **the area and the tooth roots are cleaned and sealed with a medicated filling**, the root filling is only placed during a subsequent visit, once the area is healed.




## SAVING THE TOOTH

During this treatment, your **root canals need to be cleaned out and filled with a special kind of filling**. This means your tooth will no longer be 'alive', but it will stay in your mouth so that you will not need tooth replacement.
