What is DSA?

Disabled Student's Allowance or DSA, provides financial help to students studying in higher education who have:

- A diagnosed disability
- A mental health condition
- Specific learning difficulties

DSAs are paid by Student Finance England (or Wales or Scotland), the NHS or a research council.

What does DSA pay for?

- Non-Medical Helper learning support.
- Assistive technology training.
- Specialist equipment, e.g. software

How do I apply?

- Apply on your UCAS application, or
- Complete a DSA1 application form and send it to Student Finance

If you qualify you'll need to attend a confidential Needs Assessment where an assessor identifies which support, training and equipment will benefit you the most in your studies.

You'll then receive a letter telling you what exactly you've been awarded and how to arrange it. **EASY!**

What is Non-Medical Help?

NMH is where you are assigned a Learning Support Worker or 'consultant' to help you benefit fully from your course.

Amano consultants work in these roles:

1-2-1 Study Skills Support

One to one support addresses issues some students might have in acquiring, recalling and retaining information in written and spoken language. It also provides support for students with memory, organisational, attention and numeracy difficulties.

Specialist Mentors

Highly specialist and tailored, mentors help students overcome barriers to learning created by a particular impairment, e.g. mental-health conditions, or autistic spectrum disorders.

Assistive Technology Training

Training for students in how to use their assistive technology, specialist software and hardware for learning success.

Other NMH support types are available from Amano, such as Note Taking and Study Support, but these may not be funded by DSA.
