FURNITURE RE-USE

Clear Environment will work with you to explore any available benefits from re-use within an organisation or donation cause of choice. We will only offer you this route if it meets with your organisation's social responsibilities rather than passing the problem further down the supply chain.

FURNITURE RE-SALE

Clear Environment work closely with an excellent network of commercial furniture resellers and is fully aware of current market conditions and trends. Our proposals will always be fair and realistic.

FURNITURE RECYCLE

Clear Environment experts will separate constituent parts of furniture, consolidate and effectively remove them to the appropriate specialist approved recycling facility.

FURNITURE WASTE

There will always be some. The remaining residual elements not suitable for re-use or recycling will be sent to a registered Waste Transfer Station. This only accounts for a very small percentage of the overall disposal and is fully detailed.

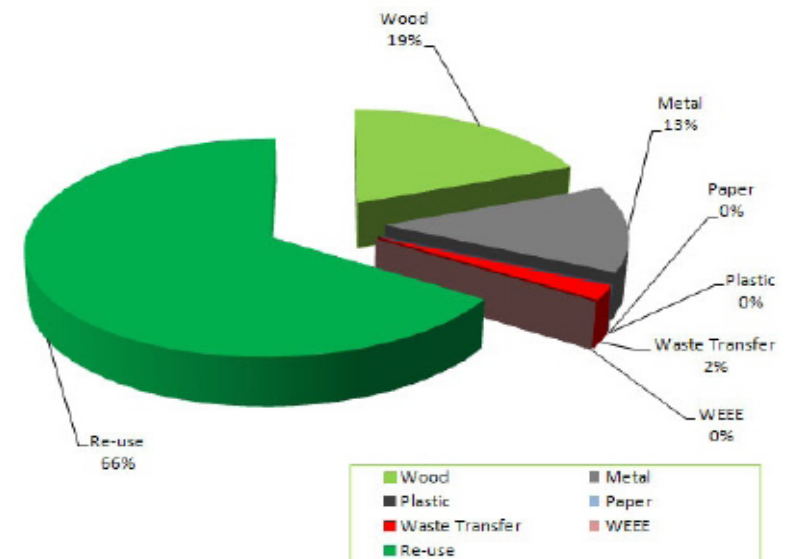


AUDIT AND COMPLIANCE

Full documentation to certify the volume of furniture disposed of and a breakdown of percentages for each material that has been recycled and re-used will be provided. An example of which can be seen on the right. The results are verified through our stringent audit process and will encompass all Duty of Care requirements

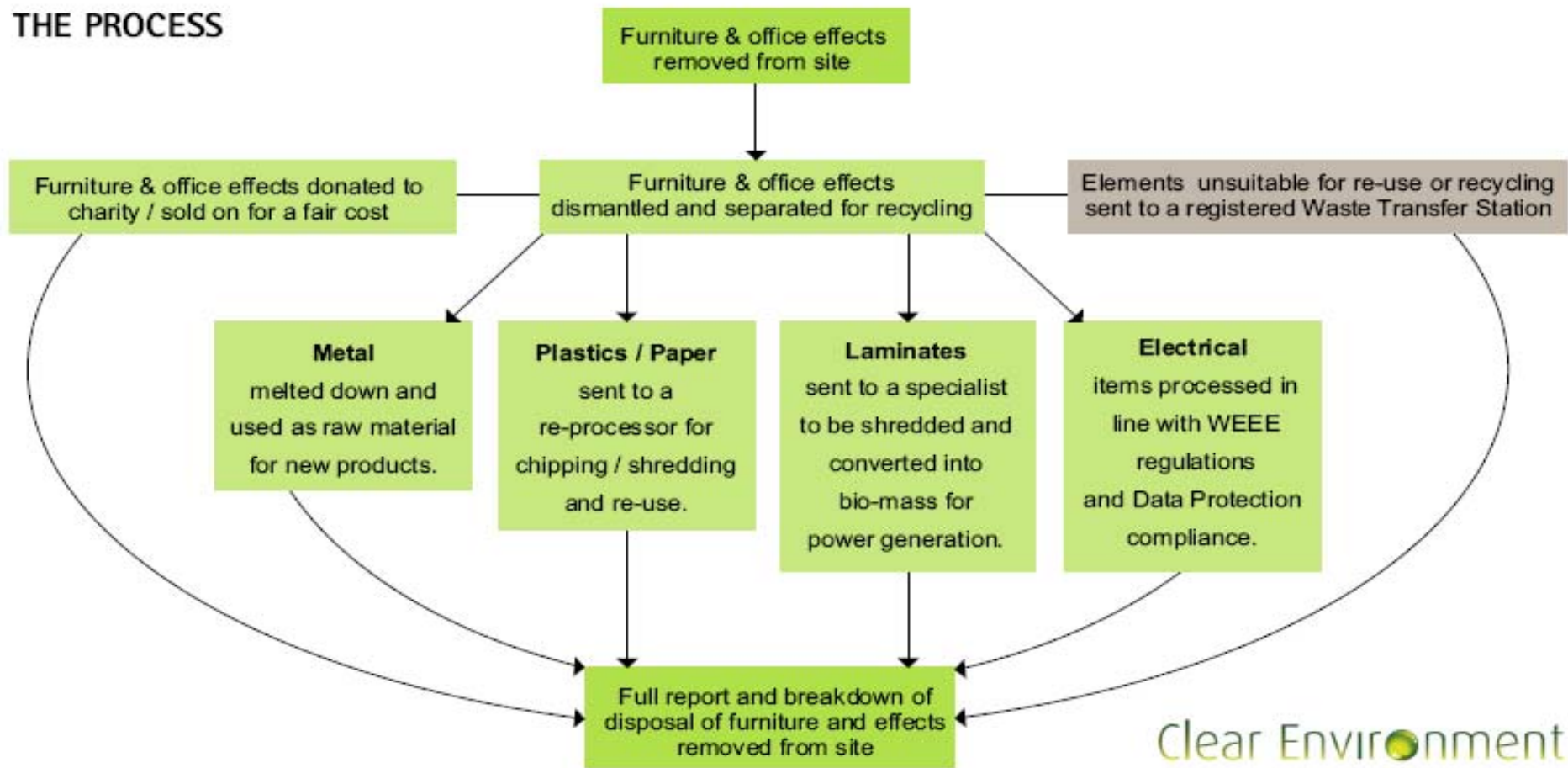
Compliance with relevant regulations include:

- Disposal of waste in accordance with the requirements of Sections 33 and 34 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990
- Environmental Protection (Duty of Care) Regulations 1991 (General office waste and furniture disposal and associated liabilities)
- Disposal of other waste including hazardous and electrical subject to the requirements of the Special Waste Regulations 1996 and Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Directive 2006 (WEEE)
- Removal and transport of 'controlled' waste by approved carriers registered under the Controlled Waste (Carriers and Seizure) Regulations 1991
- Transfer of legal responsibility under the Consumer Protection Act 1987 (Sale of second hand furniture and associated liabilities)
