





- Slightly more 18-34s drink wine in the on-trade than those who drink wine overall.


Gender




Age




What

- Overall, still wine volume has declined faster than value, reflecting the mixture of inflationary price pressure and consumer interest in premium wines.
- Sparkling wine growth continues to be very strong with value also growing ahead of volume.
- Interest in wine by the glass has grown significantly in recent years, particularly for small single serves and two large glasses – please see page 98 for Kingsland NEW Two Good range of 50cl.
- Italian wine is the fastest growing origin, driven by Prosecco. Outside of Italy, New Zealand and Argentina are best of the rest in terms of growth although they are still significantly smaller than France and Australia.




% who drink wine in the following occasions


- In general, most wine drinkers, drink wine out of home around once per month.
- A relaxing drink or informal meal are the most frequent occasions, although a formal meal and party/celebration occasions have a greater number of wine drinkers overall.




A relaxing drink out at the end of the day




With an informal meal in a pub/bar/restaurant

Hailing from South Eastern Australia, **Stoney Vale** is the block out the back of a vineyard where a creek used to flow. The 'old timers' reckon that some of the best grapes come from here as the vines have to struggle just a little bit more. It's also where the vineyard workers take their breaks under the shade of a tall gum tree and in the heat of the day there is not much movement except the odd lizard scuttling across the rocks. We call this wine Stoney Vale in recognition of this special place – in the sun drenched land we love!

AUSTRALIA FERNGROVE

Frankland River is one of the coldest and most isolated wine producing regions in Australia and as such, vintage takes place later than in other Australian producing regions, with grapes harvested as late as May. Many factors combine to differentiate Frankland River from other producing regions of Australia, including ancient, low fertile soils which make vines work harder, increasing quality rather than quantity and extremely cool ripening periods allowing grapes to ripen more slowly, delivering natural acidity and stronger varietal characters.

CHILE

Full of fascination and intrigue, Chile is a pure joy. The variety on offer from Kingsland is substantial and diverse including wines with a wide range of aromas, flavours and textures. From the cooler coastal areas and high altitude vineyards the aromatic whites and delicate reds reign supreme, whereas the Central Valley offers fuller styles of whites and more intense reds. Vinification methods are designed to enhance the typical characteristics of each variety.

CHILE TIERRA DEL REY



In 1554, whilst struggling to remain heir to the Spanish throne, Philip II of Spain married Queen Mary I of England. In order to give him equal rank with the Queen, he was renamed **Tierra del Rey**, 'King of Chile' by his father and thus became Chile's only King.

The Central Valley is set in between the majestic Andes Mountains and the mighty Pacific Ocean, making it an ideal location for growing grapes. The mountains protect the wine region by creating dry, hot climatic conditions and the cold ocean breezes keep the vines cool. This combination produces full flavoured wines whilst maintaining that all important acidity essential to make perfectly-balanced wines.


