

REACH DECLARATION

The European Union (EU) REACH Regulation EC 1907/2006 (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemical substances) entered into force in June 2007. This requires that companies who manufacture or import chemical substances into the EU evaluate those chemicals against the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) Registry.

Under the REACH Regulation EC 1907/2006 STEATITE, including its divisions, are manufacturers and suppliers of 'articles' to its customers and do not involve the 'intentional release of substances'. Accordingly there is no current requirement for registration by STEATITE.

The REACH Regulation includes the list of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC's) which require notification to the Authorities where they are present within an 'article' and their concentration is above 0.1% by weight.

Currently none of the Products or Equipments supplied by STEATITE, including its divisions, contains any of these SVHC's.

As a Company concerned with the Environment, we are active in limiting our use of materials, substances and chemicals that may be harmful to the Environment. We work closely with our suppliers to monitor the usage of chemicals and other materials and substances to ensure that we meet our Statutory, Regional and International Regulatory Requirements.
