For registered horses in Grades A&B to be ridden by adult, associate or junior members.

Numbers to qualify: points will be awarded to riders placed 6<sup>th</sup> or higher on the following scale: riders placed equal will share equally the total points attributable to the combined placings (eg. four riders placed 4<sup>th</sup> equal receive 8+4+2+0 divided by 4 =3.5 points each.

1<sup>st</sup> 64 points 2<sup>nd</sup> 32 points 3<sup>rd</sup> 16 points 4<sup>th</sup> 8 points 5<sup>th</sup> 4 points 6<sup>th</sup> 2 points

Points are awarded to each rider as the result of his/her best 6 results on points in Area Trials held during the qualifying period. Visiting members are eligible to compete in Area Trial competitions, but will not be awarded points. For the purposes only of calculating points, the placings of visiting members will be disregarded and points will be awarded to the remaining competitors according to their adjusted placings once this has been done.

Pre entries may possibly be accepted before 9am providing that the number of entries are less than 60(with the exception of County Shows). Once entries reach 60 before 9am the class will be closed. Any entries taken on the day must compete first in the drawn order.
