Challenges

When we met the team, Discover the World had an extensive calendar of travel exhibitions in the diary such as the Telegraph Travel Show at ExCel and the Adventure Travel Show at Olympia. The company planned to exhibit within a range of shell schemes and on different stand sizes so a solution was needed that would stand out and be flexible to adapt to the space.

Finding the right solution

We explored a variety of options with them such as Shell-Clad and Flexi Banners, but they were ruled out due to the limitations of lack of flexibility for displaying on different stand sizes.

Right from the beginning it was clear the ISO Frame Wave was a strong contender with its flexibility, ease of transportation, quality of the graphic content and image flow. With lots of visitors coming to the stand we also recommended two ISO Frame counters as furniture and to be used as a base which to fix iPad stands onto for extra security.

Discover the World often exhibits at events running at the same time. The ISO Frame Wave gives them extra versatility for this as it has the ability to change display size and split into two solutions, which is useful and cost effective for when it needs to be in two places at once!
