Race for Space is a popular activity that sees teams working together to build and launch their very own rocket! As part of the event, teams must firstly complete their Space Cadet Training in order to become fully fledged Astronauts before they head to the launch pad for the grand lift off finale. An event that's guaranteed to be out of this world!

What's involved?

Race for Space begins with each team being issued their Space Passport and Mission Briefing before heading off to complete the various Space Training Modules in order to reach Astronaut status.

As part of the training, teams may find themselves carrying out anything from securing their space rations and manoeuvring unique moon buggies to undertaking delicate operations to re-fuel the rocket boosters!

Once teams have successfully completed their training, they will be entitled to visit the on-site rocket shop where they will be issued with all the resources required to build their rocket - engine, igniter plugs, nose cone, parachute, rocket fuselage, recovery wadding, electron beam launch controller and launch pad.

Then it's time to build their rocket before heading off to the allocated launch zone to begin the count down.

Under the supervision of our experienced staff, the rockets are connected to the electronic firing mechanisms before the final countdown takes place and then they're off. 5... 4... 3... 2... 1...

Blast off!



If all has gone to plan, the engines flare, the rockets launch in a plume of smoke, fly to over 500 feet and gently float back down to earth on the in-built parachute.

Race for Space is a great activity for all teams and provides participants with an impressive finale as they launch their rockets from the designated launch pad.

Note: Please note that this activity requires a suitable outdoor launch area which is ideally well away from buildings, trees and main roads.
