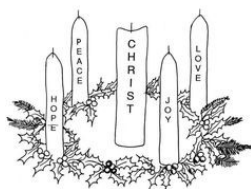

These will be on sale in the Admirals' Corner on the 4th December in aid of the "Send a Cow" appeal. See Heather Pollard for details.



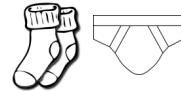
HEARTSTART TRAINING
