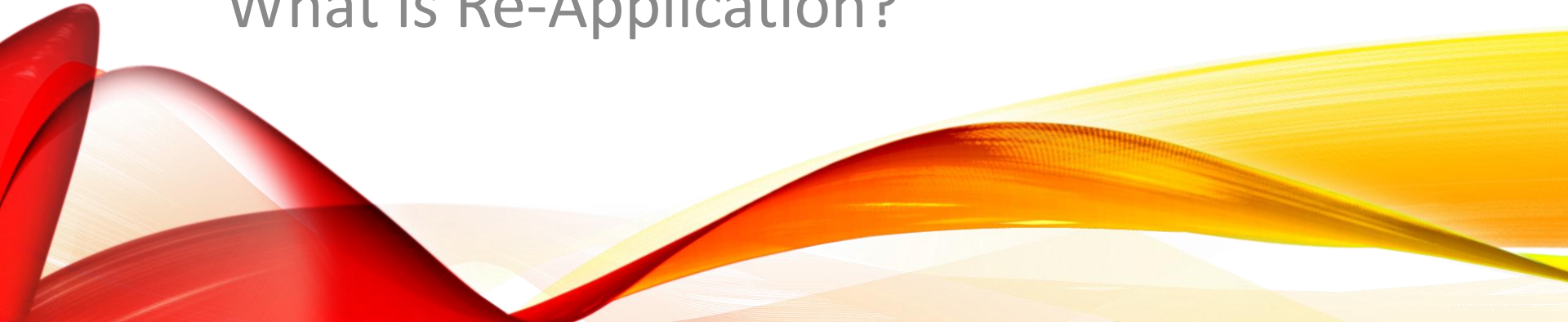

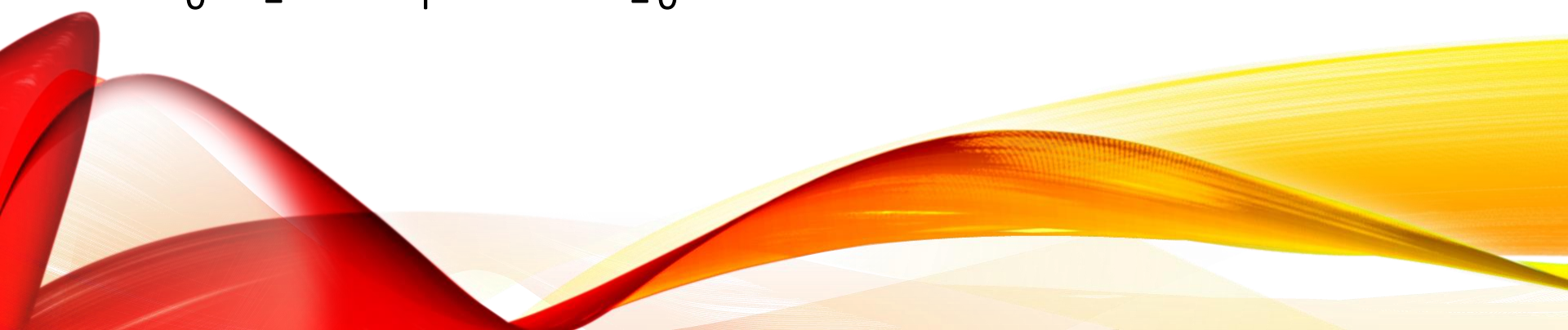
# GRADE POINT AVERAGE

# GRADE POINT AVERAGE

- Marking Period GPA:
  - This your marking period grades averaged to a number on a 4.0 scale.
- School Year GPA:
  - This is your overall GPA for the school year.
- Cumulative GPA:
  - This your final grades (made up of MP 1, MP2, and Final Exam grades) averaged to a number on a 4.0 scale.
  - Only Final grades go on your transcript.
    - This is what colleges and technical/trades schools look at when considering you for admittance to their school/program.

- The Final grades are what go on your transcript
  - This is what colleges and technical/trade schools, military, NCAA look at when considering you for admittance to their school/program.
- It also displays your cumulative GPA and your class rank.
- Total Credits Earned and Attempted
- Courses Taken

# CLASS RANK

- It is where your cumulative grade point average falls among all the students in your high school class or grade.
- Example: You may be #26 out of 306 students in your class.
- What does this mean?
  - There are 25 people in your class that have a high cum. GPA than you.
  - There are 280 people in your class that have a lower cum. GPA than you.
