#### **Beginners Cup Competition**



**Beginner A Cup Competitions** – dancers must have danced in either Beginners A Reel, A Light Jig, A Slip Jig or A Single Jig and must be Beginners A for the dance they choose to dance in the Cup Competition. Dancers can only dance in their own age group or one age group up if their own age group is not provided for on the syllabus.

#### The same rules will apply to Beginners B & C Cup Competitions.

**Pre-Open Cup Competition** - dancers must have danced in one of the Pre-Open competitions in their own age group and must be Pre-Open for the Dance that they choose to dance.

#### **RULES**

- Age as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020
- Trophies and cups must be returned one month before feis
- All objections must be lodged before results are called objections must be made through a teacher along with objections fee of €10
- The adjudicator's decision is final on all matters
- The committee reserve the right to refuse admission
- No changing of costumes in the hall dancers must be properly attired while in the hall
- No refund on tickets purchased
- Class costumes must be worn for A, B and C grade competitions in all ages and pre open and open competitions up to and including age under 9
- Children up to and including the age of 12 are prohibited from wearing face make up
- All competitors must wear their competition number pinned centre front for the adjudicators to see clearly
- White laces are permitted in poms from January 2019
- Confined competitions up to and including Under 9 will be danced under one adjudicator only
- Confined competitions up to and including U/9 should exclude those who have won the championship cup in those age groups. A dancer is not debarred from a confined competition until such time as they win a championship cup competition. Once a dancer wins a championship cup up to and including U/9, they cannot dance a confined championship until they reach U/10
- Videos/cameras may NOT be used while dancers are dancing. Photographs may be taken during prize giving.

#### **DIRECTIONS TO HALL:**

Coming from the East: Travel along the M4 Motorway heading West. When approaching Kinnegad, leave the M4 at Junction 11 (signposted Galway) and join the M6 Motorway. Leave the M6 at Junction 6 (Signposted Moate/Clara), then at roundabout take the 3rd exit, then at next roundabout take the 2nd exit onto the R420. At the next roundabout take the 1st exit onto Dublin Road and continue forward into the centre of Moate. The Hall is on the Left Hand Side just after the Church.

Coming from the West: Travel along the M6 Motorway heading East. Leave the M6 at Junction 6 (Signposted Moate/Clara) and at roundabout take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit onto the R420. At the next roundabout take the 1st exit onto Dublin Road and continue forward into the centre of Moate. The Hall is on the Left Hand Side just after the Church.
