Introduction

Employers must conduct a 'suitable and sufficient' risk assessment which is systematic and includes risk to both employees and non-employees. If the employer employs five or more people, then the assessments must be in writing.

Aims and Objectives

The course will help employers to identify significant risks and implement control measures as part of their health and safety policies.

By the end of the course delegates would be able to identify legal requirements, follow the principles of risk assessment and controls and be able to carry out basic risk assessment.
