Jill was a Girl Scout Leader before she moved to the area with her husband and two daughters Ruth and Alynn and she brought some Girl Scout ideas with her.

Over the past few years girls have learnt carpentry skills and visited B&Q to learn how to use tools safely. They started with making bird boxes, this has progressed to a larger scale Little Free Libraries.

Before Jill left the three libraries have been unveiled in Woodhouse Eaves and Woodhouse. They are themed with a book worm and as a windmill with a living roof and as Beaumanor Hall.





Each library's unique motif was brought to reality through the wood working talents of villager Mervyn Greenhaugh who worked with each team of Guides using their concepts, research and drawings. The idea is for villagers to take a book and leave a book.

Local MP for Charnwood, Edward Argar, officially opened the first library outside the Village Hall in Woodhouse Eaves in March and the final one was unveiled in August.

Bushcraft Training Weekend



Eight Leaders and 2 members of the Senior Section attended the County Bushcraft Training weekend at Topstones.

During the basic training, they learnt how to use axes, knives and saws safely, how to light fires without matches, simple cooking and how to pass these skills on to girls of all ages.

After an overnight stay in the pods, they started their Intermediate Bushcraft training by putting up shelters and

hammocks, before using the skills learnt the previous day to cook a 3 course meal using a huge variety of different methods, with and without utensils. The trout cooked in newspaper was very popular along with the delicious apple sponge cake!

We look forward to seeing more girls doing bushcraft as a result of their Leaders gaining new skills and confidence.

In early September, 6 members of the Senior Section completed their Silver DofE expedition in Derbyshire, starting at Buxton and finishing at Tissington. They didn't particularly enjoy the climb up the Roaches on the second morning, but all agreed that the views were spectacular. They showed great teamwork, and excellent navigation skills throughout and are already thinking about going on to complete Gold.

We are looking forward to another busy expedition season in 2018 and participants can register now for their awards.

GO Hints and Tips!

I hope you have all now logged in to GO, our new combined membership system? I have had a few queries and updates so thought I would pass on some hints and tips to you.

- * You need to first access the system via the email link you should have been sent round about 29th August. This might have gone into spam/junk if you haven't seen it.
- * Check and, if necessary, amend your own details. Click on your name in the top right hand corner and 'My profile'. Amend the details and click 'update' at the bottom.
- * The Help files and videos are very good so do have a look at them if there is anything you are not sure about. If you click on the 'known bugs and issues page' in the blue bar at the top of this page you can see the current issues that they are working to fix.

Unit Leaders and contacts

- For all unit access click on 'Unit Leader' > 'My Units' > unit name.
- Click on 'Young Member Enquiries' to look at your girl enquiries. On the right hand side click on the action arrow where you can add girls to your waiting list or your active girls list (click confirm role), refer to another unit or mark them as decided not to join.
- Click on 'Young Member Roles' to update details for your current active members, to end their role and to transfer them to the next section. You will also need to end a girl's role when you transfer them out. You can also download a Unit All Purpose Form and the Unit Meeting Register by clicking on the blue Young Members Roles. These can all be downloaded to Excel.
- If you want to generate Girls Individual Details forms then you will find this at the bottom of the Unit Details page. This takes a few minutes so if you click off the page and come back to it then a download link will appear at the bottom of this page.

Commissioners and level administrators

- For all District and Division access click on 'Commissioner/Level Support' > 'My Division/ District Roles' > Division/District Name.
- The first thing that appears is the District/ Division details. If you scroll down you will see Districts and Units within the level. Above the headings you can select all Active Units or just one section and then sort the lists by clicking on any of the blue headings.
- The 'Volunteer Roles' tab allows you to update the roles within your area and to add new roles. This shows every volunteer who has a role in your area.
- The 'Individuals' tab shows you all the information about volunteers who have their main role in your area. You can see their qualifications by clicking the actions arrow and selecting View Achievements.
- The 'Commissioner Management' tab > Volunteer Roles allows you to download volunteer information in various ways, including postal addresses.
- The 'Disclosures' tab shows new volunteeers who need a DBS check and existing ones who need a recheck. You need to assign an ID verifier to these so that they appear on the Verifier's list.
- The 'Learning' tab shows you all the different qualifications and courses.
