Environmental Policy Statement

The application of the base principles of using the best available technology not entailing excessive cost (BATNEEC) shape the business operations and decisions in regard to predicting and managing potential environmental impacts.

- Avoid unnecessary use of hazardous materials and products, seek substitutions when feasible, and take all reasonable steps to protect the environment when such materials must be used, stored and disposed of.
- ➤ Where required by legislation or where significant environmental hazards exist, develop and maintain appropriate emergency and spill response programmes.
- Communicate our environmental commitment to clients, customers and the public and encourage them to support it.
- Strive to continually improve our environmental performance by periodically reviewing our environmental policy in light of our current and planned future activities.
- Measurable objectives are set in striving to implement this policy statement.
