Extending Agility to the Enterprise Strategy

Today, most organizations understand the value agility can bring to the organizations. Organizations are able to respond to changing customer preferences and changing technology landscape by following agile approach.

Unfortunately, most agile approaches and frameworks such as Scrum are pretty much focused on at project and solution delivery. No organization is going to be successful just by having agility at project and delivery level without having agility at strategy level.

Agile Extension to BABoK fulfils this gap. Agile extension to BABoK emphasizes the fact agility is lot to do with change of mindset of stakeholders. The key values agile mindset espouses are

- Respect for people and the importance of creativity in delivering value,
- The importance of rapid delivery, feedback, and learning to ensure the product or service being produced meets real customer needs,
- Collaboration and communication among the team members and the stakeholder community to build shared understanding, and
- Break work into small slices of business value and deliver them incrementally and iteratively.

Strategy horizon

The emphasis in strategy horizon is to assess changes in the external and internal environments of the organization and then identify suitable initiatives for the organization. The time frame for strategy horizon is few months to few years. Depending on the stability of the environment, organization should determine right amount of duration for the strategy horizon.

Initiative horizon

Initiative horizon's focus is the initiative, which may contain one or more projects. The initiative horizon's focus is assessment and



planning of features those should be implemented on priority. These features must add significant value to organization in

the least possible time and cost. Typically, initiative horizon focuses between few weeks to few months.

Delivery horizon

Delivery horizon's focus is the solution delivery. The delivery horizon's focus is implementation of features identified in initiative horizon. Typically, delivery horizon's focus is limited to few weeks.



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IIBA® AAC Techniques Mind Map

Possessing an arsenal of techniques and knowing when and how to apply each technique will help a Business Analyst immensely in carrying out his/her work efficiently and effectively. Selecting the right technique for a particular situation can be challenging at times. To obtain the desired outcome, a BA makes use of his/her domain knowledge, experience, individual competencies, and creativity.

Several techniques can be employed successfully in a particular context. While the techniques described in the BABOK® Guide are intended to cover the most common and widespread techniques practiced within the business analysis community, the techniques described in the Agile Extension to the BABOK[®] Guide are intended to cover the most common and widespread techniques practiced within agile business analysis.

The Agile Extension to the BABOK® Guide clearly covers techniques that an Agile Business Analyst Practitioner can make use of for various purposes like communication, understanding customers, process analysis, product management/refinement, requirements management etc.

An Agile BA Practitioner can use techniques like backlog refinement, planning workshops, portfolio Kanban, retrospectives, visioning and reviews for *communication*. For process analysis, impact mapping and value stream mapping works well. For product management/refinement, techniques like minimal viable product, product roadmap, purpose alignment model, real options and Kano analysis can be used. For requirements management, techniques like behavior driven development, job stories, relative estimation, spikes, story decomposition, story elaboration, story mapping and user stories can be used. Techniques like personas, storyboarding and value modelling helps in understanding customers better.
