General statement of policy

In order to ensure that the company's safety management systems are properly structured and independently audited, the company shall continually apply to maintain its OHSAS 18001:2007 accreditation for its Occupational Health and Safety (OH&S) management system for its current scope of "The Fabrication and Erection of Pipework, Steelwork and the Installation of Plant & Equipment".
