

Requirements for Ordering/Referring

Advanced Beneficiary Designation (ABN) Form

RealTime Laboratories, <u>requires the patient to sign</u> an ABN form. The ABN is a notice given to beneficiaries of Traditional Medicare to convey that Medicare is not likely to provide coverage in specific cases. In those cases where Medicare coverage is denied, liability for payment attaches to the beneficiary.

Credit Card Authorization

We request that a Credit Card Authorization be completed and submitted with the specimen. This form of payment <u>will only be charged in the event the test is denied by Medicare</u>. Important to note that since our laboratory has started filing Medicare claims there have been positive reimbursements for your patients.

Diagnosis Code

Additionally, a DX (diagnosis code) should be included on the Requisition Form that properly supports the reason for the test being performed. Please remember that starting October 1, 2015 ICD-10 codes must be used in place of the ICD-9 codes.
