### Project Overview

The overall project encompassed the provision of audio visual and digital signage systems and solutions for a reception area, break-out room and six meeting rooms of varying sizes and utilisations.

The project included interactive touch technologies and large format monitors.

## Reception

The reception was located on the 4th floor and an open plan area with comfortable seating (see main picture). All that was required was a Sharp 60" LED screen connected to a reception second PC to allow the user to play basic PowerPoint and local generated information. The client opted for this over and above any other digital signage format as a standalone and simple solution.

## Meeting Rooms (x 3)

There were three main meeting rooms which were designated as 'interactive' locations. Again, the client decided on a simple format so 1 x 65" and 2 x 55" CleverTouch LED screens were installed along with a client supplied mini-PC (due to their security requirements) which were located behind the screens.

The users were able to interact with their own software and network set-up. A training session was provided on the use and capabilities of the CleverTouch systems. Speakers were the internal ones to the screens and control was via the hand held remotes provided with the screen. The client declined any installed remote system.

Each of the rooms was fitted with an Extron Cable Cubby with the connection cables running in underfloor channels back to the screen.

## Break Out Rooms (x 2)

Two rooms had Sharp 60" TV systems installed along with PPS mini-PCs for meeting use. It was decided that these rooms were for meeting / presentation only and did not require any form of screen interactivity.

Tables were installed with the Extron Cable Cubby.
