### **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES**

Diagnose faults on our fleet of motor vehicles and undertake necessary repair work

Complete the necessary paperwork and electronic records to the standards required

Mark and store correctly any warranty displaced parts

Identify chargeable work and report to the Workshop Manager/Supervisor

Identify work priorities and liaise with the Workshop Manager

Support and advise other members of the team including apprentices

# Describe your typical day

You know I don't have a typical day. Everyday is different. One day I could be doing a full service on a Sprinter, the next I could be repairing the side of a Luton. In a week I will have repaired or replaced clutches, engines, brakes - you name it, we do it!

# What's it like working at Northgate

The team spirit is fantastic - my team are good and the management are good. I get to talk to customers and sort out their issues as we want to get the vehicles back on the road as quickly as we can.

# What about equipment and training?

We have all the latest diagnostic gear from manufacturers such as Mercedes and since I've been at Northgate I've done the Mercedes Star training, fire marshall, health and safety and a week's workshop induction course. I'm hoping to get onto the manager training next.

How do you rate the rewards & benefits? You get 23 days holiday and an extra day on your birthday which is great. It's well paid for a technician job - there's not a lot else out there that pays the money that we get here.

I really like the shifts – I've got 3 kids so when I'm on lates I What about shifts? get to take them to school and when I'm on earlies I can pick them up. We have an hour when both shifts are here so we can catch-up on what's happening – but shifts mean we can get through so much work in a day.

# How does this compare to working at a dealership?

I've worked for Renault, Toyota and Mitsubishi and there is a real difference at Northgate. We own all the vehicles and all the parts are on site so we just crack on with what needs doing. There is no waiting around for customer authorisation and no pressure to hit sales targets.
