Futures Theatre, established in 1992, has been running extensive training courses for student social workers since 2003, which have been developed in partnership with the School of Health and Social Care, Greenwich University.

# TRAINING AIMS

Our training aims are to develop and enhance the practice skills of students by creating opportunities for them to experience complex interactions in a realistic but safe and supportive environment.

Futures use theatre techniques to help participants to:

- Develop their interpersonal and communication skills
- Rehearse working with and interviewing service users in emotionally charged situations in a professional manner
- Develop reflective, culturally sensitive and effective practice

# CONTENT

- Preparatory exercises
- Interactive forum theatre scenarios (see scenarios): Based on real case studies and situations that social workers may face, where participants work with actors to resolve real-life issues
- Group debates: Reflecting on the interactive forum theatre, sharing ideas and advice

All content is supervised and monitored by trained theatre facilitators.

# **SCENARIOS**

The scenarios we have delivered with student social workers include:

• Home visits: Dealing with manipulative behaviour

Dealing with aggression Recognising and assessing risk (adult and child safeguarding)

- Communicating with children and young people
- Engaging with service users living with domestic abuse
- Giving and receiving effective supervision
- Working effectively in multi agency groups and team meetings
- Court room dynamics and giving persuasive evidence
- Working with unaccompanied and traumatised minors

## **REQUIREMENTS & SPACE**

Futures will require:

- A minimum working space of 4m by 3m, plus enough space for participants to comfortably move around in
- Chairs for participants
- Electricity plug sockets
