## YOUR GIFT WILL MAKE A DIFFERENCE

At the Galapagos Conservation Trust (GCT), it is our mission to keep Galapagos as one of the best conserved archipelagos in the world and preserve this irreplaceable ecosystem for future generations.

Since 1995, GCT has worked to leverage the greatest impact from our conservation efforts. From species-specific studies and ecosystem-scale restoration projects, to educating the next generation of conservation ambassadors, these projects are not possible without your support.

Our programmes reflect the immediate needs in Galapagos, however, as part of our longer-term planning, we want supporters to know about the possibility of supporting GCT with a gift in your Will. By leaving a legacy you will know that the Islands and wildlife you hold dear will still be cared for long into the future.

Whether you choose to leave support towards a favoured project area, or decide it can be used to aid the projects which are most in need at the time, you can be sure that your legacy will help support essential wildlife conservation in the Galapagos Islands.

# **HOW TO LEAVE A LEGACY**

There are two ways in which you can leave a gift to GCT in your Will:

- Pecuniary gift: where you leave a specific amount of money
- Residuary gift: where you leave a percentage of your estate

The key difference is that a residuary gift tends to be inflation-proof, whereas a pecuniary gift may diminish in value over time.

Of course, when writing your Will it is essential to take proper legal advice. As a sign of our appreciation for remembering GCT, we will cover the costs of writing a basic Will.

### **OUR PROMISE**

- We understand that your family and loved ones come first
- We will never ask the size of your legacy
- We understand that there may be a time when you need to take GCT out of your Will
- We promise to use your gift for Galapagos in line with your wishes
