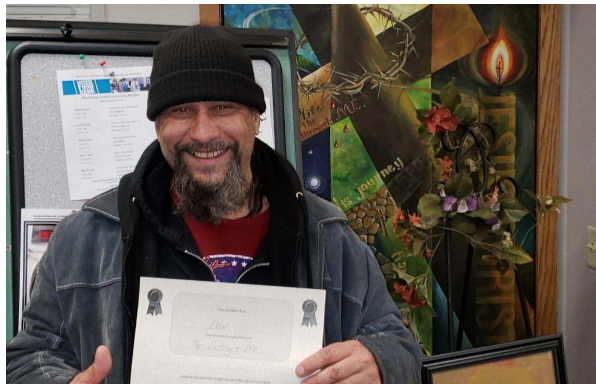

Sharing his barber skills, volunteer Gary gives Eddie a styling great haircut.



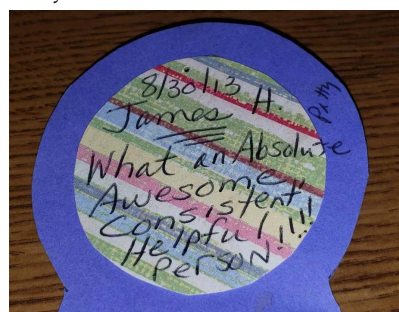
RECOGNITION MATTERS
