

THE NATIONAL FRUIT COLLECTION

Brogdale is home to the National Fruit Collection (NFC). The largest collection of temperate fruit varieties on one site.

Over 2,300 different varieties of apples, 550 of pear, 350 of plum, 220 of cherry and smaller collections of bush fruit and vines are grown in 150 acres of beautiful orchards.

BROGDALE COLLECTIONS

Established as a charity to work with DEFRA's chosen curator. Brogdale Collections has managed visitor access to the NFC in partnership with the University of Reading since the start of their curation.

We receive no government funding and rely solely on public donations and fundraising events such as this festival.

Brogdale Collections offers a range of opportunities to use the NFC as an educational resource including guided walking tours April – November, fruit days, festivals and Key Stage 1 & 2 education days.


