If you are concerned for your safety, call the HUPD at 617.495.1212 (Cambridge/Allston) or 617.432.1212 (Longwood). For medical emergencies, call 911.

The hotline operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and is run by an independent, third-party provider. It is meant for reporting of issues in situations where you don't feel comfortable speaking with a supervisor or other resource. Any concerns may be raised through the hotline, including but not limited to:

Academic misconduct

Bias-related incidents<sup>1</sup>

Conflicts of interest

Environmental health and safety concerns

Inappropriate patient care

Medical, safety, and security concerns

Misuse of University

Suspected cases of abuse or neglect involving minors in Harvard programs (the preferred method of reporting is to call HUPD at **617.495.1212**)

Violation of law, contract, or Harvard policy

Fraud/theft

Human Resource concerns
