Bitesize Torah from Rabbi Taylor

In the first verse of our parasha Korach we are introduced to On bet Pelet, a man who initially joined Korach's rebellion against Moshe's leadership of the Jewish People, but he is never mentioned again. The Talmud in Sanhedrin explains that although On did originally support Korach, his wife persuaded him that it wasn't worthwhile. She said that not only would Korach fail but also that On's status wouldn't increase under a Korach led administration – on hearing his wife's opinion On decided to leave the rebellion and back Moshe.

Rabbi Chaim Shmuelewitz explains that On's wife was successful in getting her husband to change his mind, because she was able to think logically and rationally in a heated situation and then express herself in an intelligent manner. May we learn from the wife of On, so that we always act in a measured way in all circumstances no matter how challenging they might be.
