



Cranberry Composters - Lincolnshire

Cranberry Composters based near Spilsby in Lincolnshire grew out of a farm and farm management company. Seeing a way to diversify and to produce a product that could be used to improve their own soils they opted for the VCU In Vessel Composting system.

Cranberry Composters initially installed a single chamber. However, once news of their processing plant got around they were offered some high gate fee material contracts. On the back of this Cranberry went ahead and ordered a further 2 chambers.

Cranberry have successfuly composted a very diverse range of materials:

including chicken and turkey feathers, food factory waste, pet food waste, etc. Due to the timing of the Animal by Product Regulation Cranberry were the first IVC composters in the UK to apply for, and to be approved, under the EU processing regime of achieving 70c for 1 hour. Based on this and the local requirement for processing capacity for such waste streams Cranberry have gone ahead and ordered a further seven chambers.
