Example Build Programme:

Weeks 1 - 2

You meet with your dedicated project manager to discuss your needs. A **design** is created that suits your requirements and time is allowed for any alterations you might desire. When the final design is signed off by you, we pass it to our manufacturing team.

Weeks 3 - 8

While your new cadet centre is being **manufactured** at Wernick[®] Building's specialist facility in South Wales, work is also commencing on your site. At the start of this period the site is set up, any necessary **demolition** work takes place and the site is excavated. Later, the **foundations**, **drainage** and **service routes** will be laid and checked ready for installation.



Week 9

Delivery of your building is undertaken using specialised vehicles and craned into location under the supervision of an experienced contracts manager - this process can take as little as one day!





Weeks 10 - 15

Finishing touches are applied to the interior and exterior of your building. Electrics are wired in and air conditioning is fitted. Suspended ceilings can be constructed and roofing features such as fascias and guttering are added. Later in this process the interior walls and exterior cladding are decorated in colours of your choosing. Finally, internal fixtures like shelving and blinds are added, so your centre is ready for use as soon as you open the door.

Week 16

The cadet centre is cleaned and construction site equipment is removed ready for handover. An Energy Performance Certificate for the building is issued, where required a BAFE testing certificate can be supplied. The keys to your new building will be personally handed over by your contracts manager.

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
