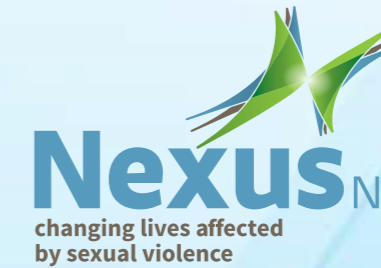

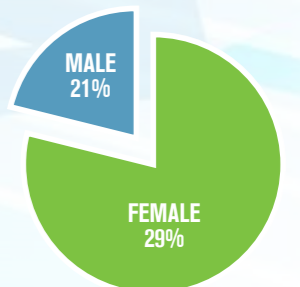
Our referrals have increased by **50%** since 2010

### AGE RANGE

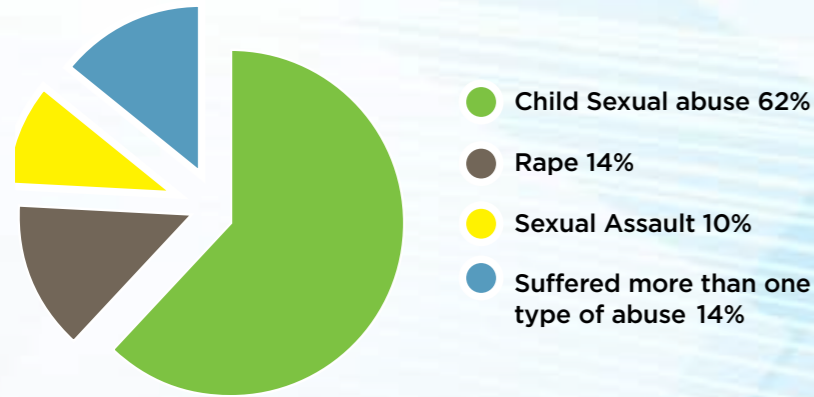

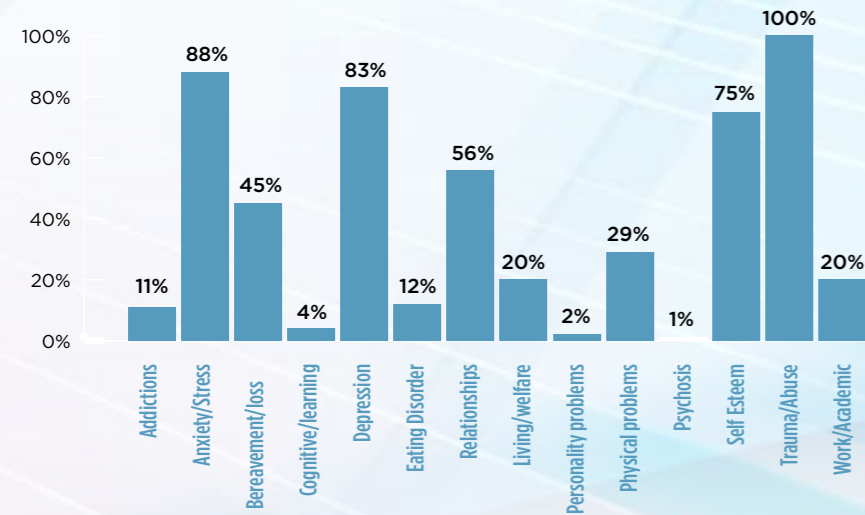


## PRESENTING ISSUES

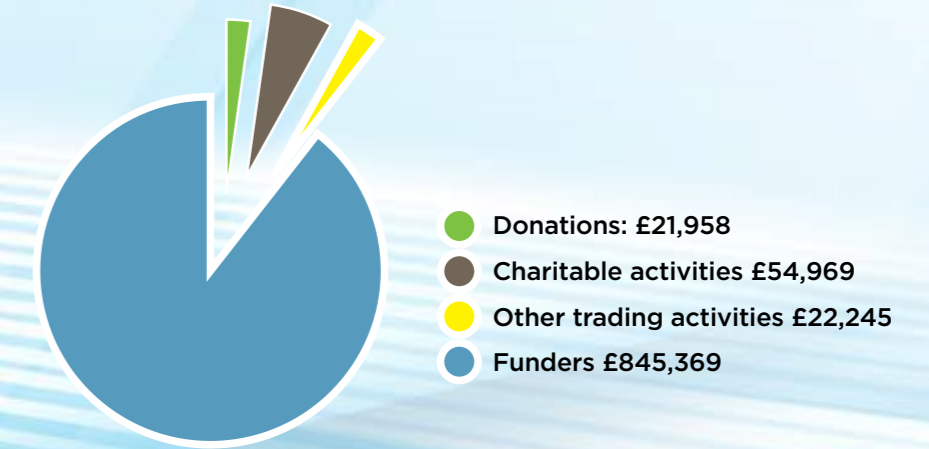
