

## EDIBLE KNIGHTON FRUIT AND NUT TREES

'Edible Knighton' is a sub-group of the Teme Valley Environment Group (TVEG) that has been quietly planting up suitable green spaces in Knighton with herbs, fruit and nut trees for local residents to freely pick, enjoy and care for.

Below is a map showing the places planted and a list of the trees you can find there. Edible Knighton would like to find local people to help look after the trees by weeding, and generally caring for them. Anyone in Knighton can pick and eat the fruit but we do need people to keep an eye on the trees and maintain them (weeding and pruning). You can either volunteer to look after a particular tree or group of trees or join a group for communal work days. ### **D - Junction The Cwm / Penybont Road**

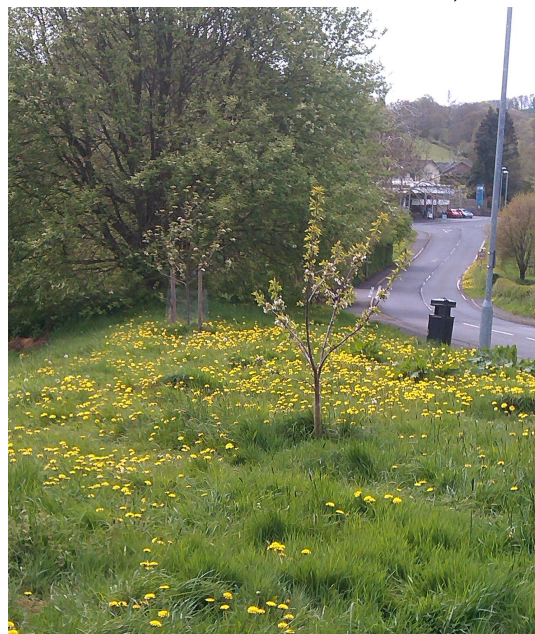
4 trees planted at beginning of 2012.

1 x **Apple**

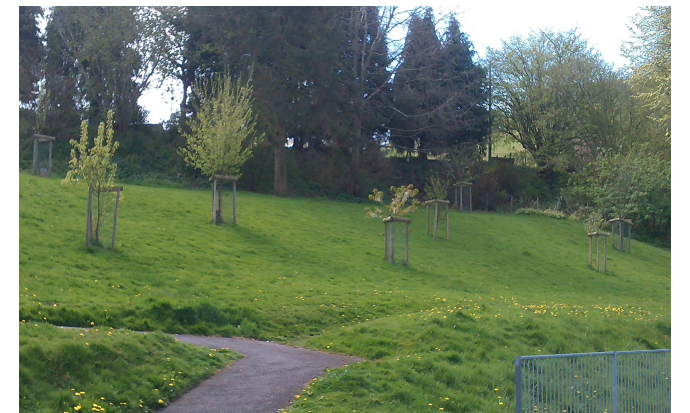


### **A - Herb Patch**
