#### Furleigh Estate Rosé, Dorset, England

(Gold Trophy winner at the IWC 2016) 60% Chardonnay, 35% Pinot Noir, 5% Pinot Meunier, this delicate rosé has an abundance of red berry fruits and makes for a perfect summer time drink. Try it with seafood, particularly prawns. £39.00
