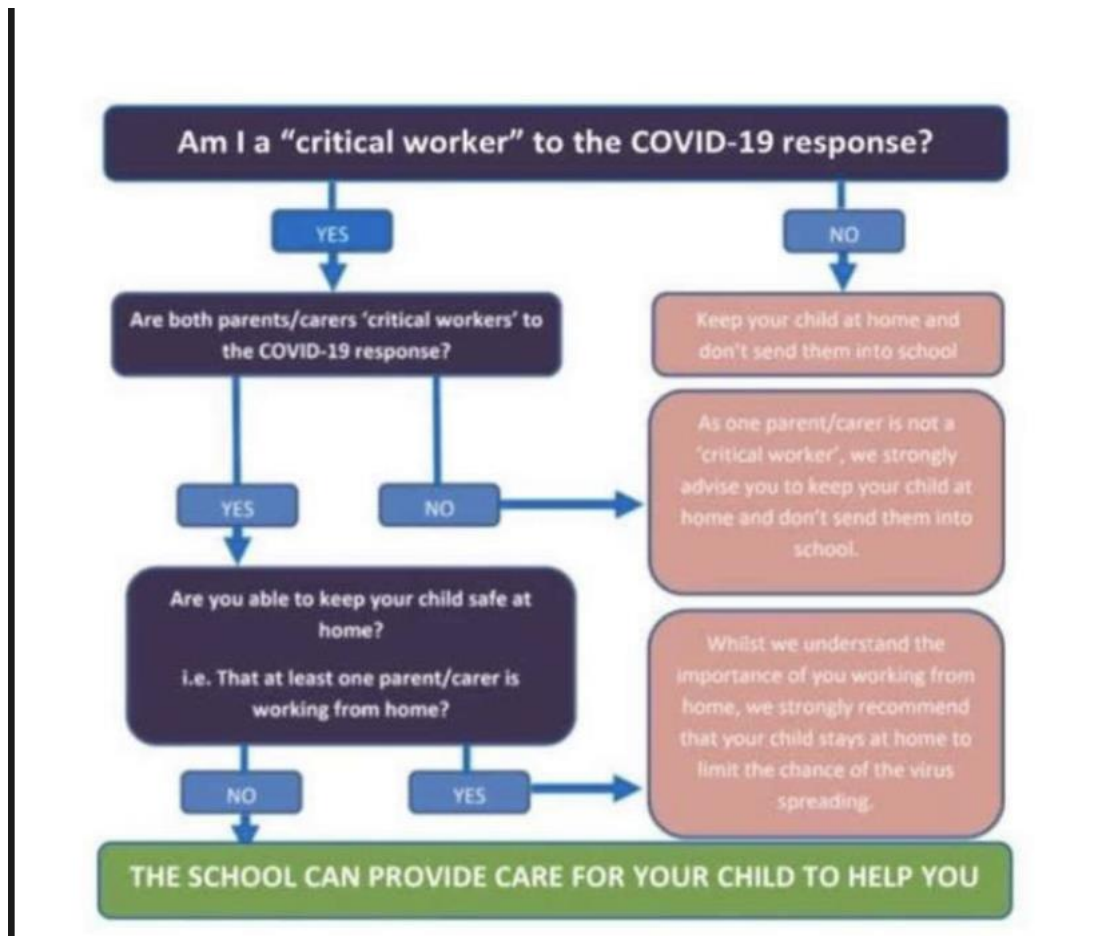

School Closure from today

As per our previous communications, St Albert the Great School is now closed to all but the children of 'critical workers' who are unable to look after their children at home. We understand that this may be creating huge challenges for families but the diagram illustrates the approach we are taking, with regard to the children of key workers, to do our part in trying to limit the spread of the virus.

As we are now operating with a skeleton staff, the office will only be open from 8:45-9:45 each morning but will be accessing e-mails regularly throughout the day. If you need to contact us please do so on this email: admin@albertthegreat.herts.sch.uk

Please note that we will only remain open if we are able to staff the site safely so will be open on a week to week basis but will let you know where possible if we expect to close.

Teachers will be uploading work from tomorrow and some may post their tasks daily and others may post a week at a time. Some staff are self-isolating so we need to be mindful of their well-being too. We are unable to provide any individual learning plans unless your child has an EHCP. Our school newsletter which was sent out on Friday provides a list of useful websites. There are also home learning activities on the individual class pages of our school website.

Thank you again for all your support and messages last week. These are unprecedented times. We remain hopeful that we will be able to re-open before the end of the summer term but will obviously be led by government guidance. If we are unable to re-open before the next academic year, we will be contacting the families of our Year 6 parents in September and will endeavour to get them together for a proper 'leaving do'.
