Requirements for both scholarships:

- High school graduate as of May/June 2020 planning to attend *OR* a student <u>currently enrolled</u> at an institution of higher education
- Applicant must be employed by or have an immediate family member employed by a company that is a member of the Sheboygan County Chamber of Commerce.
- Applicant must demonstrate a capacity for leadership.
- Applicant must show an interest in community and school activities.
- Applicant must complete Section II and must submit their typed essay on a <u>separate</u> sheet of paper.

\$1,000 scholarship - attending a 2yr. or Technical program:

- High school graduate as of May/June 2020 planning to attend *OR* a student <u>currently enrolled</u> at an institution of higher education
- Applicant must be employed by or have an immediate family member employed by a company that is a member of the Sheboygan County Chamber of Commerce.
- Applicant must demonstrate a capacity for leadership.
- Applicant must show an interest in community and school activities.
- Applicant must complete Section II and must submit their typed essay on a <u>separate</u> sheet of paper.

\$1,000 scholarship – Scholarship Committee selection

- High school graduate as of May/June 2020 planning to attend *OR* a student <u>currently enrolled</u> at an institution of higher education
- Applicant must be employed by or have an immediate family member employed by a company that is a member of the Sheboygan County Chamber of Commerce.
- Applicant must demonstrate a capacity for leadership.
- Applicant must show an interest in community and school activities.



• Applicant must complete Section II and must submit their typed essay on a <u>separate</u> sheet of paper.

- Acceptance of any other scholarship award will not preclude acceptance of this award.
- The award must be used only to assist the recipient in meeting expenses at selected college.
- Neither names of applicants nor their Chamber member affiliations are revealed to the Scholarship Committee during the selection process.
- The opportunity for an unpaid internship in Summer 2020 at the Sheboygan County Chamber of Commerce will be available to scholarship winners.
